HIGH HAND RULES

- 1. Player must be on a Jackpot eligible game
- 2. Must be 4 or more players at the table
- 3. The pot must reach \$10 or more
- **4.** If only 1 whole card plays, then you are only eligible to win half of the jackpot for that period. If both whole cards play, then you win the full amount of the jackpot for that period
- **5.** There will be only one High Hand winner each period. You must beat the posted High Hand. Stalling or discussion of a High hand may void the High Hand
- 6. In Omaha games, the hand must be made on the flop
- 7. In Stud games, the player must use two whole cards
- 8. Any game that puts out multiple boards does qualify for the High Hand on every board
- **9.** In order to collect any High Hand Jackpot payout, participants must be at least 18 years of age and have a valid ID at the time of payout
- **10.** Any dispute or situation not covered by the official rules will be resolved by Oxford Downs' Management in a manner deemed by them to be the fairest to all concerned, and that decision shall be final and binding on all participants
- **11.** High Hand Jackpot prizes that reach certain thresholds will be subject to applicable Internal Revenue Service withholding and tax reporting requirements
- 12. Any High Hand winnings not claimed within 30 days will be returned to the Promotional Fund
- **13.** There will not be any roll overs
- 14. Must have aces full or better to win

ROYAL FLUSH JACKPOT RULES

- 1. Player must be on a Jackpot eligible table
- 2. Must be 4 or more players at the table
- 3. The pot must reach \$10 or more
- 4. Player must play both whole cards
- **5.** In order to collect any High Hand Jackpot payout, participants must be at least 18 years of age and present a valid ID at the time of payout
- **6.** Any dispute or situation not covered by the official rules will be resolved by Oxford Downs' Management in a manner deemed by them to be the fairest to all concerned, and that decision shall be final and binding on all participants
- 7. All Royal Flush payouts are \$250
