TOURNAMENT RULES

- The dealer on a table will establish where the button will start on all tables for every round. They will deal one (1) card to every spot and the Highest card wins, if there is a tie on the high card, then we will go with the suits of the High cards and then determine a winner. The following is the ranking of the suits (Spades, Hearts, Diamonds, and Clubs.)
- The player's will place their wager, starting with the first spot clockwise from the button.
- The Dealer will then deal 5 cards to themselves and then two (2) to each player, starting clockwise to the button.
- Starting to the left of the Dealer Button, all players will make their pre-flop wagers. Once all action is complete (pre-flop), then the dealer will put out the flop (3 Cards). Then starting clockwise to the button, all players will either check or complete their wagering. Then once all the action is complete. Then the dealer will turn over the last two (2) cards (the Turn and the River). Then starting clockwise to the Dealer Button, each player will have to decide to call or fold at this point. Then after the players complete their action, the Dealer will then turn over their two cards. Then the Dealer will pay or collect all Bonuses or wagers, per UTH rules.
- If at any point during the tournament that you lose all your tournament chips or you do not have enough to complete a full wager, then you will be considered knocked out from the tournament. Tournament registration will remain open until the start of round 2. You may enter the tournament as many times as you like (during round 1). If you wish to put your tournament receipts into the drum so you can have a chance to receive a spot into round 2. We will draw until we have 2 separate winners. You will have one (1) minute (60 seconds) to claim your spot.
- Each round of play, you will receive a new starting stack. Your old stack does not carry over to the next round.
- Each round of play will be 15 hands. You may not choose to sit out at any point during the Tournament. You must play at least the Minium. The Minium for each hand will be 100 units, the max will be 100 times the hand you are on. Example: Hand 3 the max bet will be 300 units, Hand 7 will be 700 units etc. Once you hit hand 13, 14 and 15 you max bet can be an all-in bet. But make sure you have enough to complete your bet. After hand 12, if any player at the table wants a count of other players chips, they need to ask the dealer for a chip count. Then the dealer will break down the player's stack for an accurate count. But only at the beginning of each round. (rounds 13, 14 and 15)
- The players with the highest chip count at the end of the 15th hand will move on to the next round of play. The number of players that will be moved, will be determined by the Tournament Director.
- Once round 2 of the Tournament starts, we will then close registration.
- The Tournament payout sheet is maintained at the Hosts stand.
- The winner will be determined by the highest amount of chips in the final round of play. The rest of the field will be determined by the amount of chips from highest to lowest. 2nd, 3rd etc. or by when the players were eliminated for the Tournament. In the event of ties, the players will split the payouts equally.
- Players may agree to chop up the prize pull how ever they want. But only at the final table.
- Any unauthorized chips introduced into the tournament play will be immediately removed upon detection without substitution.
- Any parties determined to be responsible for the introduction or said chips will be disqualified without refund. It is each and every player's responsibility to bring to management's attention, unusual chips, circumstances, or irregularities.
- Tournament Director decisions are final and without recourse.
- By participating in this Tournament, Participants hereby give their permission to use their names, likenesses, etc. for promotional purposes without compensation. Management has the right to alter or cancel this Tournament.

The state of Florida assumes no responsibility for any tournaments. IRS Compliance requires a valid ID and SSN. Participants must be 18 years of age. Nonresident aliens are subject to 30% withholding. ITIN's are required for Treaty Country Exemptions. Tax form W-2G will be issued to all players winning in excess of \$5,000, net of event buy-in.
